Thank you to all the volunteers that made Wednesday youth night possible.

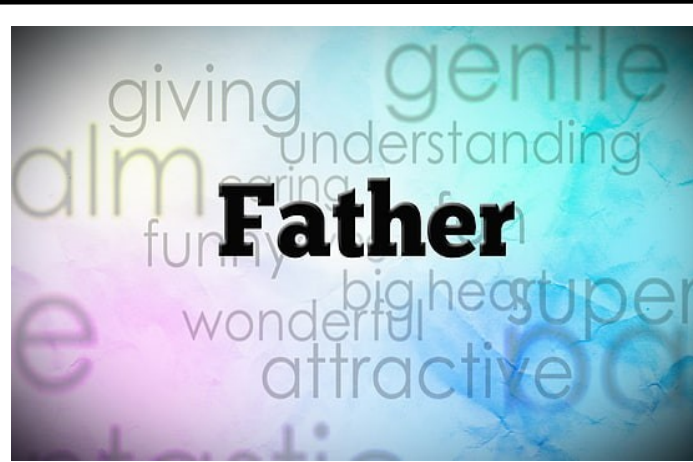
The Children and Youth Ministry activities are now on summer vacation.
